Most transports are started within 24-72 hours after accepting the offer and paying the invoice.


The air ambulance service is the top service one can think of. It's a private jet equipped up to ICU-care (ICU is the abbreviation for Intensive Care Unit). Also, we can fly patients in isolation, like covid-patients or patients with other contagious illnesses, they are flown in a so called IsoArk or EpiShuttle. It goes without saying that ground transportation is arranged and included as well. The crew of the air ambulance exists of 2 pilots, a doctor and at least one nurse. I think it needs no explanation that this is the most expensive service we offer.
